

SUCCESSFUL PEDIATRIC SURGERIES

ESOPHAGEAL ATRESIA

Baby girl born at 36 weeks, was presented at 1st day of life, referred from another hospital. She was diagnosed with Esophageal Atresia. Baby was very sick at presentation, so she was immediately put on ventilatory support & pediatric surgeon was informed. Baby was operated by our pediatric surgeon. Later on feed was established via gastrostomy tube and the baby was discharged in stable condition.



OBSTRUCTED INGUINAL HERNIA

2 months old boy, presented in E.R was diagnosed with Obstructed Inguinal Hernia. He was immediately admitted and initial labs were sent. Anesthesia fitness was taken and baby was operated by our pediatric surgeon. He was transferred back to NICU and was discharged in stable condition.

- 1% to 3% of all children
- 3% to 5% in preterm baby
- R 60% L30% Bilateral 10-15%
- Males to females ratio is 6:1 - Present as bulge in the groin,
- scrotum, or labia.
 A reliable history is sufficient to make the diagnosis, even if the
- hernia cannot identify.


 An incarcerated inguinal hernia presents as a mass in the labia or scrotum that does not reduce spontaneously.
- The hernia should be repaired electively; the parents should be warned about possible incarceration in the meantime.





PYLORIC ATRESIA, SITUS INVERSUS & MALROTATION OF GUT

Baby boy was delivered at Ali Medical Centre via LSCS at 37 weeks. On antenatal scan he was found to have double bubble sign and polyhydramnios. He was admitted soon after birth and was diagnosed to have pyloric atresia, situs inversus and malrotation of gut. Gastrojejunostomy was done by our pediatric surgeon. Feed was gradually established and the baby was discharged in stable condition.
